TOURNAMENT CALENDAR COMPETITION REGISTRATION - FOR 2011 SEASON

The Tournament Council handles the organisation of the Tournament competition Calendar. It is IMPORTANT that Federations register their 2011 competitions according to the rules below:

- **2011 E&A** Titled Events, International Record Capability, Cash Prize 1 and Cash Prize 2 events must be registered with the Tournament Council prior to **08 November 2010**
- Other **International Ranking List** competitions must be registered with the Tournament Council prior to the **15th January 2011**.
- **All competitions** must be applied for on the TC Competition Registration Form (enclosed - please copy as many as necessary)
- **International Competitions not registered on the E&A Calendar may be homologated to Normal level only.** But please also note E&A Additional Rule 8.2 - If the Organisers of a competition **announced as a National Competition** accept an entry from a skier not entitled to enter under Rule **8.1** his Federation must be shown on the results **and the homologation level for any foreign skiers is limited to Normal.**
- **There is no charge for registration of competitions up to the date of the E&A Congress (usually last weekend of January).**

The E&A Byelaws detail a system of fines as follows:-

- If competitions are **added** to the calendar after the Congress, the following fines will be levied :
 - Fine up to March 1st : 100 Euro.
 - Fine from March 2nd up to May 31st : 200 Euro.
 - **Competitions cannot normally be added to the calendar after May 31st.** However, Federations may apply to the E&A TC for permission to add a competition up to 30 days before the proposed start date of the competition. The E&A TC will decide if the competition is allowed to be added to the calendar. If it is allowed a (late) fine of 400 € will be levied. In the case of Cash Prize or Record Capability Homologation, the organiser must submit the names of their proposed jury panel at the time of the application.
- Fine for **changing** dates or place of a calendar competition after March 1st €100.
- Fine for **cancelling** a calendar competition after March 1st €200.

FEES PAYABLE FOR 2011

Titled events

Cash Prize 1 events where cash prize is more than 7,000 €	10% of cash prize or 2,500 € whichever is less. Organisers are reminded airfares of officials are payable as per Byelaw 4.5.2
Cash Prize 2 events where cash prize is between 2,500 € and 7,000 €	

Homologation Fees

The homologation fees are payable on the submission of an homologation dossier, even if the homologation or the homologation level is refused.

The fee for a Normal homologation is €100 and for Rankings List or Record Capability €200.

The Tournament Council will give one free homologated event per country per year.

Schedule of Calendars

The E&A TC will publish the first calendar "Calendar A" following its November meeting. This will contain all the Titled, Record Capability, Cash Prize 1 and Cash Prize 2 events that have been registered in due time.

After the E&A Congress in January the TC will re-publish Calendar A. They will also publish "Calendar B" which will contain all other international events than those that come under Calendar A.

Appointment of Officials

- The E&A Tournament Council will appoint panels **only** for Titled events, International Record Capability events, Cash Prize 1 and Cash Prize 2 events.
- **For other events** officials may apply to the host Federation who shall be responsible for appointing the panel of officials according to the rules published in the Tournament Additional Rules

Notification to Officials

Officials will be invited to apply to the E&A TC (in the usual way) for appointment to Titled events, International Record Capability events, Cash Prize 1 and Cash Prize 2 events. If any organisers have a preference for officials they may notify the E&A TC Chairman and we will try to assist in these wishes, provided the named officials have applied.

All qualified officials will be sent a copy of Calendar B and invited to contact the host Federation or organiser if they wish to be on the officials panel for any of those events.
